Basic Errors

- The rest of the class needed more help with finding fractions of amounts. Common errors included forgetting when to use their times tables, and assuming that, for example, finding one third of an amount would give the same answer as finding two thirds of the same amount. Will include these types of questions in FAD going forward.
- Fractions of operators was a challenge for most of the class. Main reasons were forgetting to convert $12/4$ into 3 or recognising that if $1/3$ of $6=2$, then $2/3$ of $6=4$ because $2 \times 2=4$.
