

Maths Year 5 Unit4 Decimals and percentages Week 3 - 2024-25 (28.4.25)

Work to Praise and Share

- Most children could round a decimal number to the nearest whole number with accuracy
- Jaxson, Ben, Alice, Josh, Lucas and Olivia were very good at problem solving questions involving rounding. Aniyah also reached this far but not as comfortable with the problem solving questions
- Theo, Oscar and Millie-Anna (up to question 3) all got further than usual with the rounding tasks - Theo in particular was very accurate when rounding to 1 decimal place.

- Presentation Highlights
- Good start by all to our work on percentages, with all of them showing a sound understanding of finding a percentage out of 100.
 - Most children were able to compare simple percentages and fractions, and it was good to see the pre-teaching intervention group using their extra help to understand how to convert 'one-fifth,' 'two-fifths' etc into percentages.

Support Needed

- Ivy and Caine needed help with consistently rounding to 1 decimal place (tenths) while Claudia, Lyla and Elsie worked through slowly but accurately
- Millie-Anna and Caine very slow when finding simple equivalent fractions and percentages - will see if they find equivalent decimals and percentages easier.

Basic Errors

- Some reminders needed that .5 rounds up as opposed to 'staying the middle'
