Work to Praise and Share

- Class very good at reading coordinates from a grid and most could remember as well as use the 'along the corridor, up the stairs' saying to help them.
- Majority of the class could use a numbered coordinate grid to find the missing coordinates, while only some could use blank grids
- Most of the class found translation much easier with coordinates than without.

Support Needed

- Caine, Poppy, Max, Aniyah, Ivy and Skyla struggled when finding the missing coordinates even with a numbered grid
- Caine, Poppy, Lyla and Sonny struggled with translating even when using a coordinate grid.

Presentation Highlights

Basic Errors

- Some early issues with plotting coordinates if one of the digits was a 0 - will work on this over the next few lessons.
- More practise needed with numberless coordinate grids.
- Most of the class need to be more accurate when translating a shape accurately in a certain direction/up or down a certain number of squares.
