Work to Praise and Share

- Whole class knew 'how many months in a year,' 'how many hours in a day' etc and most could work out the number of hours in a larger number of days etc.
- 26.6: Josh, Oscar, Millie, Ivy, Jensen, Ben H, Aniyah, Isabella, Lucas and Alice were very good at using timetables to calculate time differences, arrival and departure times etc even when using 24-hour times.

Support Needed

- When calculating with timetables, most of the class (excluding the names mentioned on 26.6) found it tricky to use 24-hour times and work out time differences from one time to another. These children were, however, better at working with the layout of the bus timetable than the TV guide.

- There was a lot of confusion during the lesson on metric and imperial measurements, with most children struggling to convert using the decimals.
